(BLESSING ONLY) – NO FEE

Parents may request a quinceañera or sweet 16 blessing within a regularly scheduled Mass on the weekends. Generally these type of blessings are requested during our Saturday 4pm English Mass. If you choose this option please follow the following guidelines:



- 2. The Quinceañera must be dressed in her Sunday-best attire (no quince dress). Please do not take away from the liturgy by showing up with your quince dress, we request this be reserved for the hall/home celebration. The Mass is a time of sacred worship and warrants all respect of all participants. Coming dressed in your quince dress will distract others from the Mass.
- 3. Absolutely NO attendants/15era court (ladies or chamberlains) are allowed. This is reserved for the hall/home celebration.
- 4. It is recommended that the Quinceañera and her family have celebrated the Rite of Reconciliation (confession) within two weeks prior to the celebration.
- 5. During the Mass, the birthday girl is called before the altar after communion for her special prayer and blessing.
